The agreement paves the way for a collaborative effort between Porter County & the Twin Creeks Conservancy District to plan, design, construct, and maintain storm water management projects within Old South Haven, New South Haven, Coventry, and Salt Creek Commons. Porter County will be principally responsible for the implementation of such projects, but the Twin Creeks Conservancy District will remain involved in the overall effort.

Our initial focus will include the rehabilitation of the storm water management system in Old South Haven as well as an assessment of the storm water infrastructure serving the remainder of the neighborhoods within greater South Haven.
