**ORDER TO SHERIFF TO IMPLEMENT EVICTION ORDER
AND ASSIST IN ORDER OF POSSESSION**

- Prejudgment Order of Possession was entered on the ___ day of _____, 20 __.
- The Sheriff of Porter County was Ordered to transfer possession of real estate located at:

from the Defendant(s) to the Plaintiff(s) no later than 30 days following the issuance of the Prejudgment Order of Possession.
- The Defendant(s) was in open court, heard the Prejudgment Order of Possession and understood the terms, date, and time of eviction.

- Defendant(s) failed to appear for eviction hearing. The Plaintiff chooses the following method of service to notify the Defendant(s) of Prejudgment Order of Possession:
 Plaintiff will personally serve Order on Defendant(s).
 Sheriff to serve and service fee is paid.
 Clerk to serve by certified mail (fee paid, if applicable).
- Plaintiff seeks the assistance of the Sheriff (Civil Bureau) to evict Defendant(s). Porter County Ordinance #06-16 requires a pre-paid fee of \$100.00. The Court Orders that upon proof of payment of \$100.00 fee (either paid now to the Clerk of the Court or paid prior to eviction), the Sheriff (Civil Bureau), agents and officers of the Porter County Sheriff shall evict Defendant(s) pursuant to the Prejudgment Order of Possession.
- Plaintiff understands that this Order supercedes the Prejudgment Order of Possession and that if the Porter County Ordinance Fee is not paid prior to eviction; the Plaintiff has impliedly waived use of the Sheriff for eviction purposes and the Sheriff will NOT be reporting to the site of the eviction.
